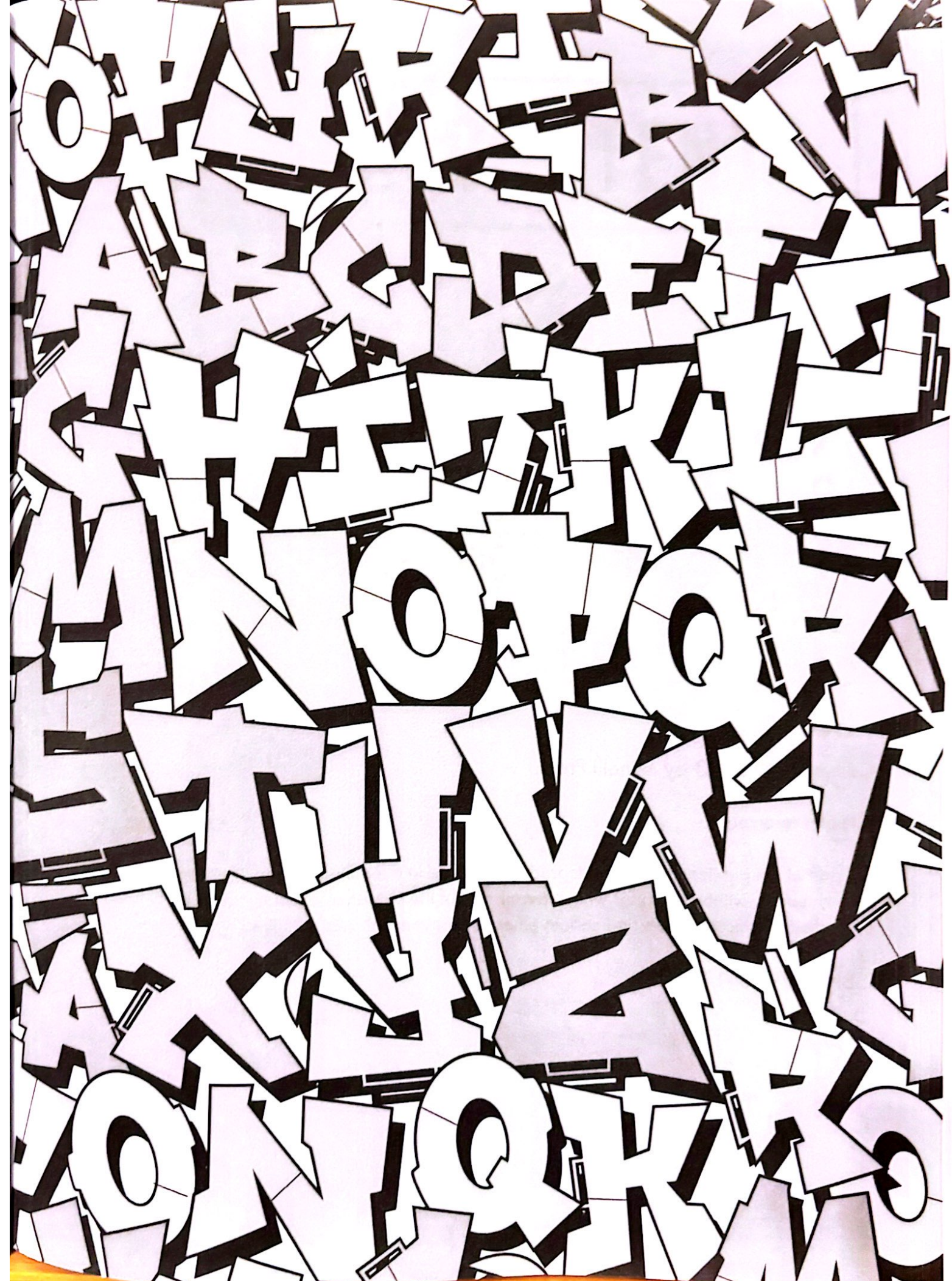

BOOK INTRODUCTION



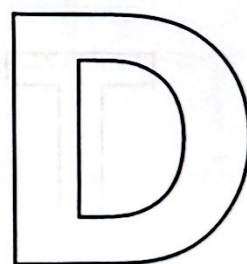
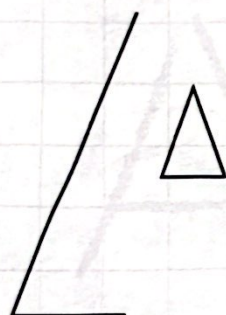
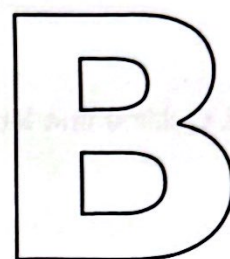
To create graffiti lettering, you will need a few key tools and materials, including:

1. Pencils
2. Eraser
3. Artist Pens. *For outlining and adding the finishing touches, artist pens have fine points and a smooth glide ink that makes it easy to draw precisely.*
4. Paint Markers. *These markers are perfect for filling in the designs you draw with the artist pens. The bold colors are highly pigmented and dry quickly, so there is less smudging.*
5. Use thick paper to prevent bleeding. *Very important!*

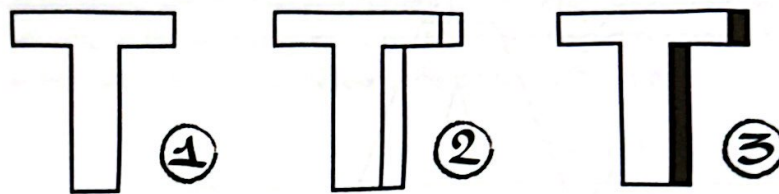

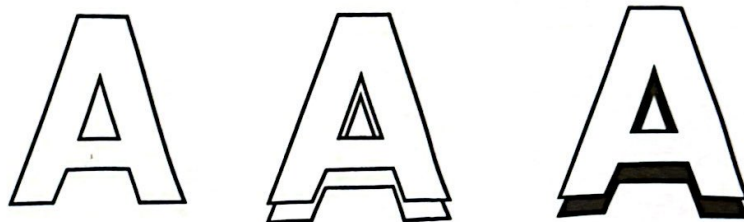

LEARN THROW-UP STYLE STEP-BY-STEP

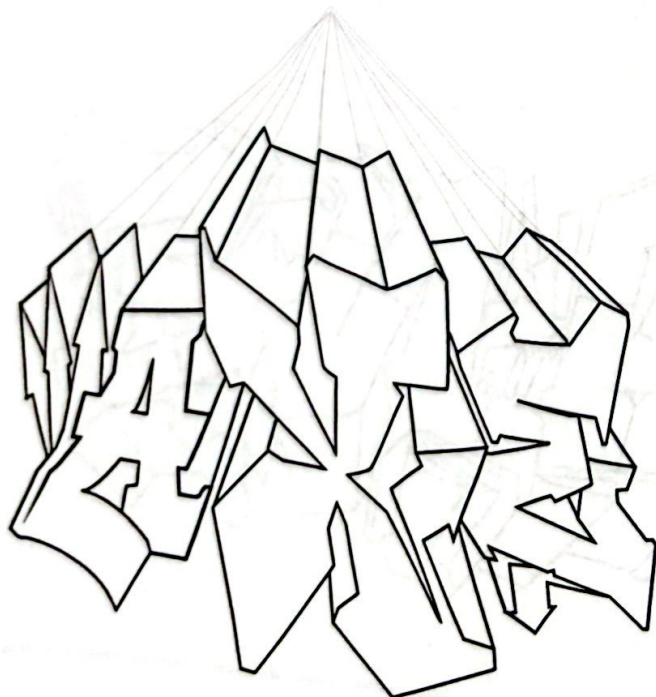


Perspective volume is based on our peripheral ability and allows us to draw more realistic objects, as if they exist in the real world with a deep volumetric look. When combined with soft shadows and texture, it can achieve really interesting results.



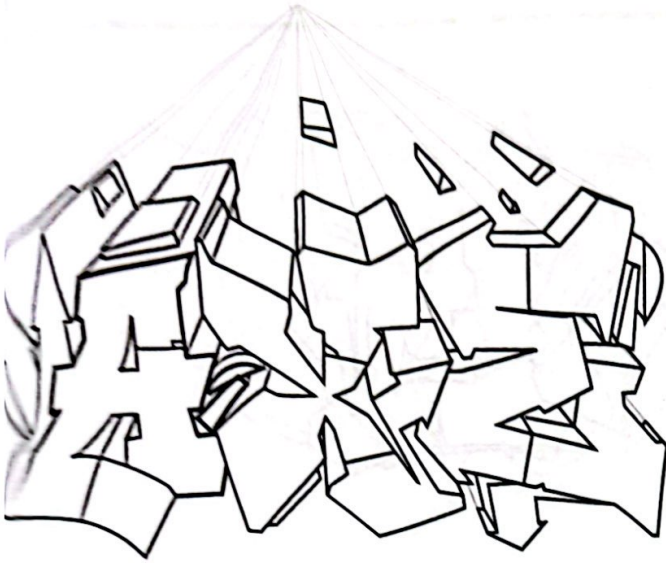
All edges of your graffiti piece should converge at a point on the horizon, but you can vary the length of the lines to show their thickness or thinness.

For instance, creating a thinner volume in the center can make your letters appear slightly curved



Combine a larger volume with a larger letter to make it pop out in your graffiti design!

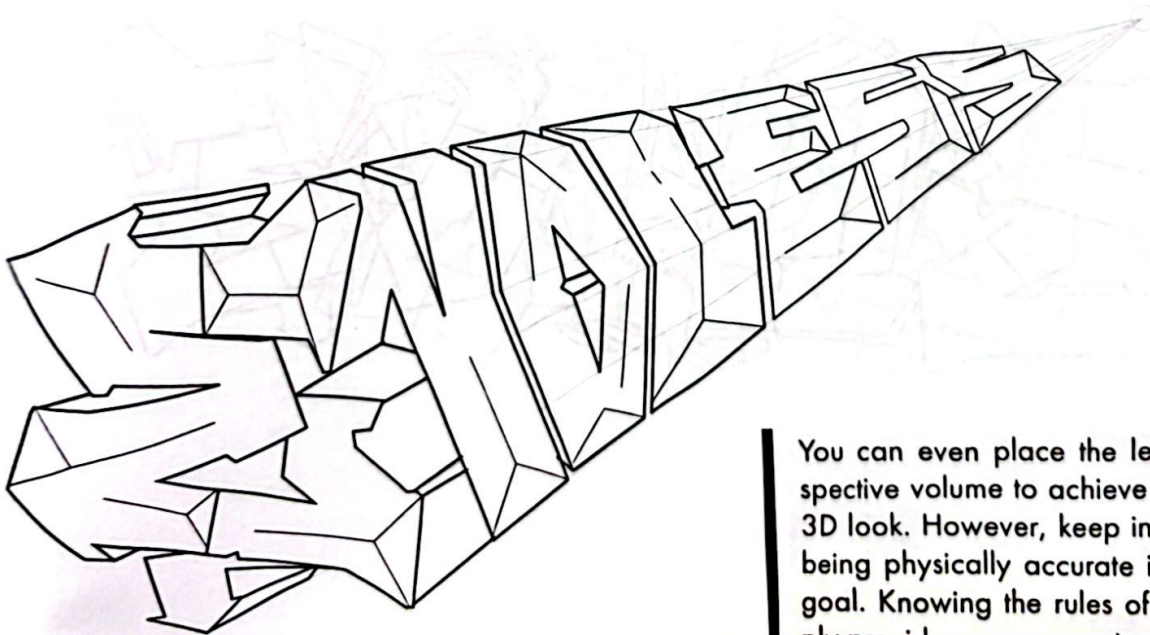
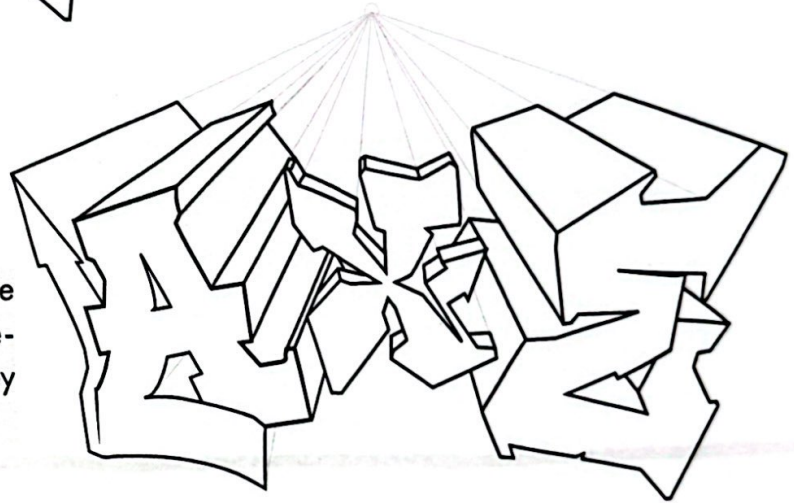
Experiment with squeezing and shearing your letters to achieve more variations in perspective and volume



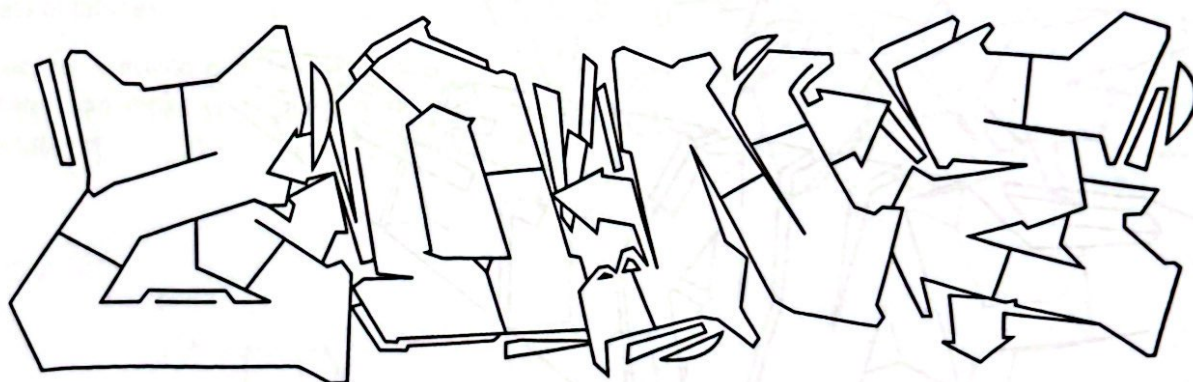
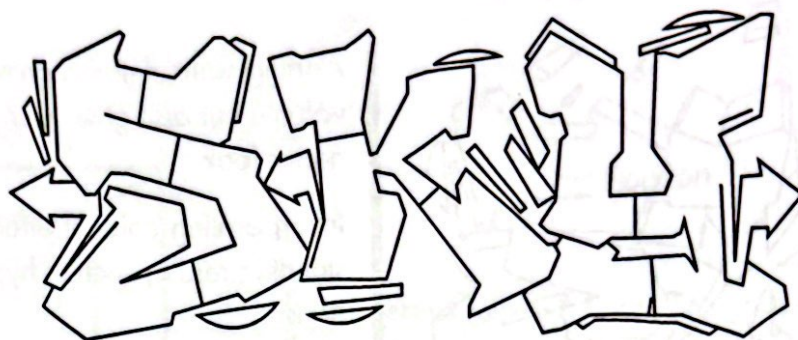
Adding some details can not only enhance the volume but also give your graffiti design a dynamic look.

Incorporating colorful effects can lead to outstanding results, such as hyper-jumps or explosions.

Consider experimenting with some extreme variations such as using completely flat elements or making your letters so long that they extend to the horizon.

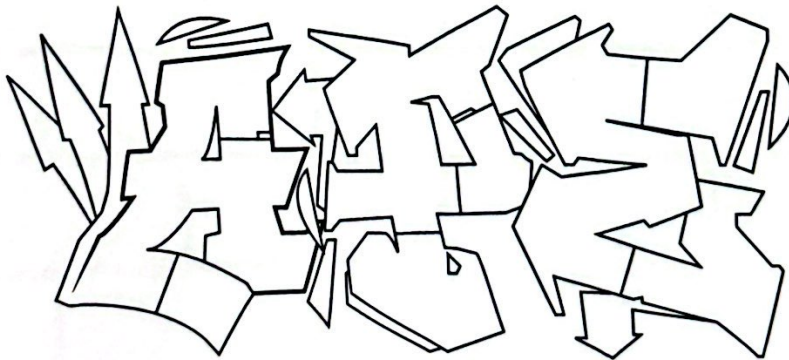
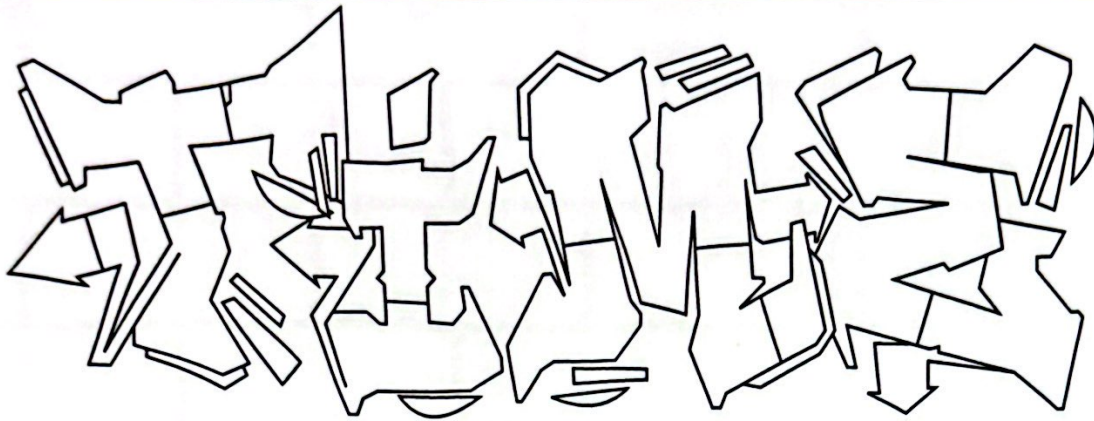


You can even place the letters on the perspective volume to achieve a more complex 3D look. However, keep in mind that in art, being physically accurate is not always the goal. Knowing the rules of perspective simply provides more opportunities to bring your ideas to life the way you envision them.
